

The Death Christ Died

Mark 15:33-47

- I. Doctrinal Truths seen in Christ's Death (Mark 15:33-38)
 - A. Darkness for 3 hours: *My God, My God, Why have you forsaken me?*
 - The Doctrine of **Propitiation**: Christ satisfied God's just wrath upon our sin (1 John 2:2; 4:10).
 - B. Christ's Death: *Loud Cry – It is finished* (John 19:30).
 - The Doctrine of **Redemption**: Jesus finished the payment for sin – releasing us from condemnation (Mark 10:45; Romans 3:24,25; Ephesians 1:7).
 - C. Temple Curtain Torn: The curtain on the “holy of holies” in the temple was torn by God.
 - The Doctrine of **Reconciliation**: Jesus' death removed the barrier between Holy God and sinful man. (Hebrews 6:19-20; Romans 5:10,11).
- II. Historical Proofs following Christ's Death (Mark 15:39-47)
 - A. Jesus truly died (15:39-45)
 - The centurion witnessed Jesus' death and acknowledged that He was the Son of God (39).
 - The women witnessed His death (40-41).
 - When Joseph of Arimathea asked for Jesus' body Pilate verified His death with the centurion (42-45).
 - B. Jesus was truly buried (15:46-47)
 - Joseph buried Jesus in his tomb and rolled the stone in place (46).
 - The women saw where Jesus was buried (47).
