

When Heart Burn is a Good Thing!

Luke 24:13-32

(Speaker: Jim Engelman)

1. “Were not our **hearts burning** within us while He was speaking to us on the road, while He was explaining the Scriptures to us?” – Luke 24:32
2. **From defeat** – “And they stood still, looking sad (their faces downcast)” – Luke 24:17
This comes from our subjective view of God – God meeting my needs.
3. **From despair** – “But we were hoping that it was He who was going to redeem Israel.” – Luke 24:21
This comes from not understanding God’s program.
4. **From unbelief** – didn’t believe the women (24:22) & didn’t believe Peter (24:34)
Confusion in our hearts and minds causes us to not believe the truth.
5. **To Faith** – through Jesus explaining from Scripture – “Was it not necessary for the Christ to suffer these things and to enter into His glory?” – Luke 24:26
Result: A transformation of life through faith in the truth of God’s Word and the replacement of defeat, despair and unbelief with confidence in Christ and His promises.
