

What We Will be Like in Heaven

Heaven – Part 2

- I. **No Sin (Moral Perfection)**: There won't be any sin, because it is a place of complete Righteousness
 - A. We will be holy in heaven (Revelation 3:4,5; 4:4; 6:11; 7:9, 14; 19:14).
 - B. We are sinners who become holy (Revelation 21:27; 7:14; 1 Corinthians 6:11; Romans 5:1).
 - C. As we struggle with sin, we must already pursue holiness (Romans 7:18-24; 1 Peter 1:8; 1 Peter 1:13-16).

- II. **No Sickness (Physical Perfection)**: There won't be any sickness because we will have a glorified new body without the effects of sin
 - A. Sin caused sickness and death (Genesis 2:17).
 - B. Our temporary, current body will suffer until it is replaced (Romans 8:22-23; 2 Corinthians 5:1-6).
 - C. Our new resurrection body is eternal and perfect (1 Corinthians 15:42-44; 50-53).

- III. **No Sorrow (Emotional Perfection)**: We won't experience sorrow because there will be no more effects of sin.
 - Our feelings of loss, grief and regret will be gone because God's presence overwhelm and removes those effects of sin (Revelation 21:4).
