

His Majesty and Me Psalm 8

Main Point: God is gloriously above all that He created, yet graciously involves mankind in His glory.

I. God is majestic (Psalm 8:1-2).

- A. God is majestically displayed by the heavens He created.
- B. God's glory is shown by the children who praise him.

II. We seem insignificant (Psalm 8:3-4).

- A. The heavens are His handiwork.
- B. Compared to God's created world, we seem like nothing.

III. Yet He graciously honors us (Psalm 8:5-8).

- A. He thinks of us and gave us glory.
 - We are made in God's image (Genesis 1:26-27).
- B. He thinks of us and gives us meaning.
 - Example: We rule over the animals (Genesis 1:26).

IV. God's glory and grace confirms His true majesty (Psalm 8:9)!
