Passing on a Legacy of Praise
Psalm 145

- I. Teach children about God's greatness (Psalm 145:1-7).
 - A. We must daily praise God for his greatness (1-3).
 - B. We must teach the next generation to praise Him for His greatness (4-7).
- II. Tell the world about God's grace (145:8-20).
 - A. We as believers must praise God for being gracious and good to all (8-10)
 - B. We as believers must tell the world of God's glorious rule over all (11-13a).
 - C. We as believers must tell the world of God's grace shown to all (13b-20).

His Grace Common to All

1. *Faithful* – Keeping His promises to all (13b)
2. *Loving* – Benefitting all (13c)
3. *Upholding* – Helping all (14)
4. *Giving* – Providing food for all (15)
5. *Open Handed* – Satisfying many desires all have (16)
6. *Righteous/Loving* – Doing what is right but loving to all (17)

His Grace to Believers

1. *Draws Near* – Personally close to those who seek Him (18)
 2. *Fulfills desires* – Satisfying desires of those who worship Him (19a).
 3. *Delivers* – Answering prayers of those who cry to Him (19b)
 4. *Watches over* – Directing the safety of those who love Him (20)
- III. God deserves constant praise (Psalm 145:21)!
 - He deserves my praise and the praise of all forever
