
SERMON OUTLINE

Worship Christ the King Hebrews 1

Main Point: God first spoke through human servants, but now speaks through His supreme Son whom He sent to earth.

- We worship God's Son because He is greater than any human prophet (Hebrews 1:1-3).
 - Jesus will inherit everything (1:2).
 - Jesus created everything (1:2).
 - Jesus radiates God's glory (1:3).
 - Jesus is exactly like God His Father (1:3).
 - Jesus sustains the whole universe (1:3).
 - Jesus alone could pay for our sin (1:3).
 - Jesus is enthroned as God's equal (1:3).
- We worship God's Son because He is greater than the angels (Hebrews 1:4-14)
 - Jesus was fully honored as Son when resurrected (1:5; Psalm 2:7; Acts 13:33, Hebrews 5:5).
 - Jesus is God's eternal King as well as David's eternal Son (1:5; 2 Samuel 7:14; Rom. 1:3).
 - Jesus deserves the worship of angels (1:6; Psalm 97:7; John 5:23).
 - Jesus commands, while angels only receive commands (1:7; Psalm 104:4).
 - Jesus is God – and will rule someday with believers (1:8-9; Psalm 45:6-7; Heb. 3:14).
 - Jesus is eternal and unchanging (1:10-12; Psalm 102:25-27).
 - Jesus will reign forever while angels serve believers who live forever (1:13-14; Psalm 110: 1).
