

## UNSHAKEABLE BECAUSE OF HIS GRACE

Hebrews 12:25-29, p. 976

- I. THE MIGHTY GOD SHAKES HEAVEN AND EARTH, BUT BELIEVERS ARE UNSHAKEABLE (HEBREWS 12:25-27).
  - A. If those at Mt. Sinai feared God's warnings, we who are saved by grace must also heed His warnings (25).
  - B. God's warnings shook the earth at Mt. Sinai, but one day He would shake earth and heaven through Jesus (26; Haggai 2:1-9 – Jesus' presence makes the temple truly glorious).
  - C. Although the present heavens and earth will shake and be removed, we belong to an unshakeable eternal kingdom (27).
    - God will destroy and recreate the heavens and earth (Isaiah 51:6; Matt. 24:35; Heb. 1:10-12; 2 Peter 3:7-12; Rev. 21:1).
  
- II. AS PART OF GOD'S UNSHAKEABLE KINGDOM, WE MUST FOCUS ON GRATEFUL WORSHIP AND SERVICE (HEBREWS 12:28-29).
  - A. We belong to God's eternal kingdom through Jesus Christ (28a; 22-24; Revelation 21-22).
  - B. We must live motivated by gratitude for God's grace (28b; Titus 2:11-12; 2 Corinthians 5:14-15; Romans 12:1-2).
  - C. We worship God by serving Him in reverence because we know we are spared His judgment (28c-29; Deut.. 4:24)!
