SERMON OUTLINE

Freed from the power of sin Colossians 2:11-15

- I. <u>Rituals</u>: Circumcision and baptism symbolize our need for Christ's power (Colossians 2:11-12).
 - A. <u>Circumcision</u> was an external symbol under the law of mankind's need for internal transformation by Christ (11).
 - B. <u>Baptism</u> is now an external symbol of our faith in the power of God to give us new life through Jesus Christ (12).
- II. <u>Reality</u>: We are now spiritually alive because Christ triumphed over sin at the cross (Colossians 2:13-15).
 - Me are no longer enslaved to sin because we are now spiritually alive through Christ (13a).
 - B. <u>We are no longer condemned</u> because our sin debt is forgiven and removed by the cross (13b-14).
 - C. <u>Satan no longer has power</u> over us because the power of sin is broken by Christ's victory (15).
