

GOD'S HEART FOR YOU IN HEBREWS

Hebrews 13:20-25, p. 977

- I. WHAT GOD DID FOR US THROUGH JESUS CHRIST (HEBREWS 13:20).
 - A. The God of peace: God has provided you peace now and forever (20a; Romans 5:1; Philippians 4:4-7; Isaiah 9:6-7 etc.).
 - B. God resurrected Jesus, establishing His eternal covenant (20b)
 1. The blood: God provided eternal life through the death of Jesus who established the eternal covenant.
 2. The resurrection: God completed His plan of salvation by raising Jesus from the dead (1 Corinthians 15:1-8).
 - C. Jesus Christ is the Great Shepherd of His Church. (17b).
 1. Jesus the great shepherd saved and now guides us.
 2. We as sheep must always live dependent on Jesus.
- II. WHAT GOD WANTS TO DO IN US THROUGH JESUS CHRIST (HEBREWS 13:21).
 - A. God wants to equip you for the work He planned for you (21a).
 - B. God wants to grow you in personal spiritual maturity through Jesus Christ (21b).
 - C. God wants your life to glorify Jesus Christ forever (21c).
