

Why we meet  
Colossians 3:15-16

I. As we meet, Christ transforms our relationships  
(Colossians 3:15).

- A. *Let the peace of Christ rule* – Christ’s goal of peace must become our goal in our church family (15a).
- B. *Be thankful* – When we submit to Christ’s centrality, we are grateful for each other (15b).

II. As we meet, we communicate with Christ  
through His word and worship (Colossians 3:16).

- A. *Let the word of Christ dwell richly* – We must let Christ’s wisdom permeate our minds (16a).
- B. *Teaching and admonishing one another* - We learn Christ’s will as we meet to teach each other (16b).
- C. *Singing to God with gratitude in our hearts* – We grow in gratitude for Christ as we praise God with various songs (16c).
