SERMON OUTLINE

What disciples must understand John 13:31-38

- I. <u>The glorious cross</u>: The tragedy of the cross leads to the glory of God (John 13:31-33).
 - A. The cross would be a win, not a loss The cross will display God's glorious power and love (31-32).
 - B. Christ must leave to accomplish on the cross what no one else could (33).
 - Application: The core motive of ministry is to glorify God through the message of the gospel.
- II. <u>Contagious love</u>: Imitating Christ's love becomes the impact of the church (John 13:34-35).
 - A. The disciples must love one another sacrificially like Christ (34).
 - B. The world would understand Christ by how the disciples loved each other (35).
 - Application: Evangelism begins in the challenge of Christian relationships.
- III. <u>Tested commitment</u>: Our intention to follow Christ will be tested by reality (John 13:36-38).
 - A. Feeling committed Peter, you can't follow me now no matter how committed you feel (36-37).
 - B. Failing at commitment Peter you will fail me before you truly follow me (37-38).
 - Application: We must recognize the difference between the emotions of commitment and the reality of sacrifice.
