The need for truth with the goal of love 1 Timothy 1:1-7

- I. Greetings: A letter from Paul to Timothy (1 Timothy 1:1-2).
  - A. *Apostle* Paul, the apostle, had the authority of God and the message of Jesus Christ (1:1).
  - B. Son in the faith Timothy came to faith through Paul (1:2a).
    - 1. Timothy was from Lystra, where Paul had been stoned for preaching (1:2; Acts 14:8-20; 16:1-5).
    - 2. Timothy's mom and grandmother were believers, but not his dad (Acts 16:1; 2 Timothy 1:5).
  - C. Grace, mercy, peace God's blessings trifecta
- II. Timothy, address false teaching for the sake of the gospel and love (1 Timothy 1:3-7).
  - A. <u>Truth</u> We will not accomplish God's purpose unless we stay focused on God's word (1:3-4).
    - 1. Don't tolerate false doctrine and trivial debates which lead to division in the church (3-4a).
    - 2. Focus God's work of salvation through faith (4b).
  - B. <u>Love</u> We will not love one another unless we stay focused on God's word (1:5).
  - C. <u>Truth and love are lost</u> when proud people teach distracting, worthless and false things (1:6-7).
