- I. WHEN XERXES DESIRED A QUEEN, GOD HAD PREPARED ESTHER THE BEAUTIFUL JEWISH GIRL (ESTHER 2: 1-7).
 - A. King Xerxes missed Queen Vashti and liked the plan to gather the most beautiful girls for him to choose a new queen (1-4).
 - B. Mordecai the Jew had raised his orphaned young cousin Esther who was exceptionally beautiful (5-7).
- II. WHEN ESTHER WAS TAKEN INTO THE HAREM, SHE WAS FAVORED BY THE HAREM MANAGER (ESTHER 2:8-11).
 - A. Hegai favored Esther with the best food and lodging (8-9).
 - B. Esther did not reveal she was Jewish, obeying Mordecai (10-11).
- III. WHEN ESTHER TOOK HER TURN WITH THE KING, HE CHOSE HER TO BE HIS NEW QUEEN (ESTHER 2:12-20).
 - A. Esther took with her to the king only what Hegai advised (12-16).
 - B. King Xerxes chose Esther as His queen and celebrated lavishly, but Esther never revealed her Jewish identity (17-20).
- IV. AFTER ESTHER BECAME QUEEN, COUSIN MORDECAI FOILED A PLOT AGAINST THE KING (ESTHER 2:21-23).

Principles

- 3. God controls information that is hidden and what is known.
