God's unclaimed goodness

2 Kings 13, p. 302

- SCORNING GOD'S GRACE: KING JEHOAHAZ KEPT SINNING AFTER GOD GAVE MERCY (2 KINGS 13:1-9).
 - A. God punished King Jehoahaz and Israel for idolatry by giving Aram/Syria victory over them (13:1-3, 7).
 - B. God was compassionate and delivered Israel when King Jehoahaz sought God (13:4-5).
 - C. The king and nation continued to worship idols (13:6-9).
- II. SQUANDERING GOD'S POWER: KING JEHOASH MISSED OUT ON TOTAL VICTORY (2 KINGS 13:10-24).
 - A. Jehoash continued the sins of previous kings (13:10-13).
 - B. While dying, Elisha offered Jehoash victory, but the king didn't fully trust or care if God did it (13:14-19).
 - C. When dead, Elisha brought a man back to life (13:20-21).
 - D. God showed gracious compassion to Israel in spite of their sin because of His covenant promises (13:22-24).
