Praying for the main things 1 Timothy 2:1-7

Intro: The purpose of this book (1 Timothy 3:15)

- Living as God's people in a world needing truth
- I. Pray for WHOM? We must pray to benefit all people (1 Timothy 2:1-2).
 - A. We should pray about the needs of others and thank God for everyone (2:1).
 - B. We should pray for governing authorities to allow us to live peaceful, godly lives (2:2).
- II. Pray for WHAT? We must pray for all because God desires all to be saved (1 Timothy 2:3-7).
 - A. <u>We pray</u>: Praying for all pleases God who desires all to be saved (2:3-4; 2 Peter 3:9; John 3:16-18).
 - B. <u>God saves</u>: Jesus paid it all (2:5-6).
 - 1. *Mediator*: There is one God and Jesus is the only mediator between God and man (5).
 - 2. *Ransom*: Jesus is the only way to heaven because He paid the only payment for sin (6).
 - C. <u>We tell</u>: God works to save people as believers tell unbelievers about faith in Christ (2:7).
