SERMON OUTLINE

Why abiding in Christ is so important John 15:6-11

<u>Theme/Context</u>: We can bear much spiritual fruit, but only if we abide in Christ (15:5).

- I. If we <u>don't</u> abide in Christ <u>our life is</u> worthless in its impact (John 15:6).
 - "Branches" = Believers who choose whether or not to abide in Christ (15:1-5)
 - "Abide" = Fellowship with Christ, not salvation.
 - "They will cast them" = The world has contempt for believers who don't display what it means to be Jesus' disciples (John 13:35, 15:8).
- II. If we abide in Christ, <u>God answers our</u> <u>prayers</u> so <u>God will be glorified</u> as we bear fruit as Christ's disciples (John 15:7-8).
 - God answers prayers of those who abide in Christ because then we ask for what Christ wants.
- III. If we abide in Christ, we will experience his love in a personal way (John 15:9-10).
 - We are loved by Christ like He loves the Father.
 - As we obey we experience God's love like Christ does.
- IV. If we abide in Christ, we will experience true joy through our relationship with him (John 15:11).
