Connected to Christ and abiding in Him

Ephesians 1:15-23, page 947; John 15:1-5, page 876

- I. <u>PRAY</u> THAT THOSE CONNECTED TO CHRIST GROW IN THEIR RELATIONSHIP WITH CHRIST (EPHESIANS 1:15-23).
 - A. We must pray for each other to know God relationally (15-17).
 - B. We can know God relationally who gave us all our spiritual blessings in Christ (18-21).
 - 1. Hope of our calling We are confident of heaven (18a).
 - 2. His glorious inheritance We are God's "wealth" (18b).
 - 3. *His great power* We have access to Christ's power (19-21).
 - C. We must recognize Christ's authority over the church (22-23).
 - The world doesn't submit to Christ, but His church must!

II. ABIDE IN CHRIST TO BEAR SPIRITUAL FRUIT WITH THE POWER OF CHRIST (JOHN 15:1-5).

- A. Christ is the source of all spiritual growth and strength (15:1).
- B. Christ takes us where we are and enables us to bear fruit (15:2).
 - God <u>lifts up</u> branches who are <u>not bearing fruit</u> ["lift up," not "take away"] and <u>prunes</u> branches for <u>more fruit</u> (2).
- C. Christ produces fruit/impact through us only as we <u>abide in Him</u> pursue close fellowship with Him (15:3-5; 1 John 1:3-7).
