Differences removed and unity created

Ephesians 2:11-22, page 947

- I. <u>GOD REMOVED DIFFERENCES</u>: GOD REMOVED BARRIERS TO CREATE UNITY IN CHRIST (EPH. 2:11-18).
 - A. Gentiles were formerly excluded but are now included with Jews <u>through Christ's blood</u> (Christ died for all 11-13).
 - God saves all people on the same basis of the cross (1:7).
 - B. Jew and Gentile believers have <u>equal status</u> with God (14-18).
 - 1. Christ <u>made peace</u> by ending the ceremonial law (14-15a).
 - 2. Christ <u>created</u> a new man (the body is a "third race" 15b).
 - Christ <u>reconciled</u> the "body"/church to God by the cross, and gave all equal access to God through the Spirit (16-18).
- II. <u>GOD UNIFIED VERY DIFFERENT BELIEVERS</u>: WE ARE JOINED TO EACH OTHER IN CHRIST (EPH. 2:19-22).
 - A. All believers are fellow <u>citizens</u> (19a).
 - B. All believers are part of the same <u>household/family</u> (19b).
 - C. All believers form a <u>building</u>, a <u>temple</u> of the Holy Spirit (20-21).
 - The church's <u>foundation</u> is God's word (apostles, prophets). The <u>Cornerstone</u> is Christ (Savior and Head of the body).
