

LIVING WITH THE LONG VIEW

Hebrews 10:32-39, p. 974

- I. DON'T FORGET YOUR ZEAL AND SACRIFICE WHEN YOU WERE FIRST SAVED (HEBREWS 10:32-34).
 - A. They were insulted, imprisoned and property confiscated (10:32-33a).
 - B. They endured because they supported each other and kept an eternal perspective on material possessions (10:33b-34).
- II. NEVER GIVE UP LIVING BY FAITH BECAUSE GOD ETERNALLY REWARDS ENDURANCE (10:28-29).
 - A. God richly rewards the believer who is faithful in the long haul (10:35-36).
 - B. Jesus is returning soon to reward, so don't be the Christian who gives up or drifts away (10:37-38).
 - God eternally rewards faithfulness (1 Corinthians 3:11-15).
 - C. Don't give up trusting God, but endure and thus preserve the eternal value of your life (10:39).
