Knowing your own spiritual condition Haggai 2:10-23

- I. Doing more religious things doesn't make you godly (Haggai 2:10-14).
 - A. Haggai questions the priests Sin is contagious, but holiness is not (10-13).
 - 1. Purity If holy meat in a pocket touches something, does holiness transfer? Answer: No.
 - 2. Contamination If a dead body touches something, is it contaminated? Answer: Yes
 - B. Haggai's application for the priests Everything we DO can be tainted by sin if our hearts are not right (14).
 - Religious activity is not the same as godliness.
 - Know who/what influences you spiritually.
- II. Sin causes problems but genuine godliness brings God's blessings (Haggai 2:15-19).
 - A. God used poor harvests to get their attention (2:15-17).
 - Sometimes there is a link between our problems and our sin (Hebrews 12:6-11).
 - B. God would bless seed planted that year (2:18-19).
 - God always blesses obedience in some way.
- III. God would bless Zerubbabel with honor in future generations (Haggai 2:20-23).
 - A. God would destroy all Israel's enemies (20-22).
 - B. God would honor Zerubbabel by continuing Christ's line through him (23; Matthew 1:12, 16).
