## God's control of evil Revelation 11-12

- God is in control when his servants are attacked
  Opposition to God's two witnesses in the Tribulation (Revelation 11:1-19).
  - A. God will protect believers, but allow His enemies power over Jerusalem (1-2).
  - B. God will commission 2 witnesses to prophesy and judge the earth for 3 ½ years (3-6).
  - C. God will allow the Antichrist to kill His 2 witnesses, causing worldwide celebration (7-10).
  - D. God will resurrect His witnesses taking them to heaven while an earthquake kills 7000 and survivors are forced to glorify God (11-14).
  - E. God WILL be glorified in heaven for what He is doing on earth (15-19).
- II. God controls Satan throughout history and prophecy – Satan's opposition to Israel in the Tribulation (Revelation 12:1-17).
  - A. War on earth Satan has always opposed Jesus and Israel, but God protects them (1-6).
  - B. War in heaven Satan will battle angels in heaven until God expels him to earth where faithful believers ultimately win (7-12).
  - C. War on earth Satan will pursue Israel but God will protect them in the wilderness (13-17).
