## Care for each other carefully 1 Timothy 5:1-16

- I. Church leaders must address <u>spiritual</u> needs carefully (1 Timothy 5:1-2).
  - A. Correct older men graciously like a dad (5:1a).
  - B. Care for others as if they were family (5:1b-2).

Principle: Leaders can't excuse being harsh or improper.

- II. A church must meet <u>physical</u> needs carefully (1 Timothy 5:3-16).
  - A. The ministry of the church to widows (5:3-8)
    - 1. Honor truly needy widows with support (5:3).
    - 2. Carefully evaluate who to help 5:4-8).
      - Should family help instead (4, 8)?
      - Does she pursue God or live sinfully (5-6)?
      - Be accountable for being careful (7).

<u>Principle</u>: Give generously, but discern the truly needy.

- B. The ministry of widows to the church (5:9-15)
  - 1. Supported widows must be part of a ministry serving others (9-10).
    - Must be 60+ with good reputations
  - 2. This ministry is not for young widows who must avoid sin and hopefully remarry (11-15).

<u>Principle</u>: Those who receive must seek ways to serve. <u>Principle</u>: Character matters for givers or receivers.

C. Married women should personally help widows in their family so the church won't need to (16).

<u>Principle</u>: Don't expect the church meet a need if you can.
