God's hand of direction Ezra 7

- I. Summary: God's hand directs us when we are committed to His word (Ezra 7: 1-10).
 - A. God's hand enabled Ezra to lead more Jews back to Jerusalem (1-9).
 - Ezra was in the priestly line of Aaron (1-5).
 - Ezra had success through God's hand (6-9).
 - B. God directed Ezra because he was devoted to God's word (10).
 - Ezra studied, obeyed & taught God's word.
- II. The letter: God's hand controls events as we pursue godly purposes (Ezra 7:11-26).
 - A. <u>Spiritual care</u>: Artaxerxes authorized Ezra to go check on the Jews spiritually (7:11-14).
 - B. <u>Worship</u>: Artaxerxes authorized donations and royal financial aid for worship (7:15-24).
 - C. <u>Apply and teach truth</u>: Artaxerxes authorized Ezra to appoint judges and teach (7:25-26).
 - When we commit to do God's will He shapes circumstances and directs our decisions to accomplish His will (Proverbs 3:5-6).
- III. Praise: God must be praised when His hand supports and directs us (Ezra 7:27-28).
 - A. Ezra praised God for the king's support (7:27).
 - B. Ezra led courageously because God's hand clearly supported the plan to return (7:28).
