

FAITH TO DO HARD THINGS

Hebrews 11:23-29 p. 975

- I. BY FAITH, MOSES' PARENTS COURAGEOUSLY DEFIED PHARAOH TO SAVE MOSES (HEBREWS 11:23).

- II. BY FAITH, MOSES COURAGEOUSLY IDENTIFIED WITH ENSLAVED ISRAEL NOT PRIVILEGED EGYPT (HEBREWS 11:24-26).
 - A. Moses did not let the pursuit of pleasure distract him (24-25).

 - B. Moses did not let wealth distract him from obeying Christ (26)

- III. BY FAITH, MOSES COURAGEOUSLY FACED PHARAOH AND LEFT EGYPT (HEBREWS 11:27-28).
 - A. Moses did not let the king's anger deter him (27).

 - B. Moses obediently celebrated Passover which preserved life and established continual worship for Israel (28).

- IV. BY FAITH, ISRAEL COURAGEOUSLY FOLLOWED MOSES THROUGH THE RED SEA (HEBREWS 11:29).
