- I. CHILDREN LEARN TO FOLLOW CHRIST'S AUTHORITY AS THEY OBEY THEIR PARENTS (Ephesians 6:1-3).
 - A. Children must obey parents because that's how they obey Christ (1).
 - B. Honoring parents at all ages is rewarded by God (2-3; Exodus 20:12).
- II. DADS (AND MOMS) MUST LEAD GRACIOUSLY TO GUIDE CHILDREN TO LIVE UNDER CHRIST'S AUTHORITY (Ephesians 6:4).
 - Don't provoke your children to anger by your own hurtful attitudes or areas of neglect (6:4a).
 - B. Instead, graciously and intentionally teach your child how to obey Christ (6:4b).
