HOW STEWARDS HANDLE PROSPERITY 1 Timothy 6:17-19

- I. <u>BE HUMBLE</u>: DON'T BE ARROGANT IF YOU ARE WEALTHIER (1 TIMOTHY 6:17a).
 - Arrogance (I deserve what I have) is the opposite of stewardship (I manage what God owns).
- II. TRUST GOD: DON'T PLACE YOUR HOPE IN UNCERTAIN WEALTH (1 TIMOTHY 6: 17b).
 - A. Don't put your faith in money since it can be lost or taken away.
 - B. Trust your future to God who generously blesses us so we can gratefully enjoy His gifts.
- III. <u>BE GENEROUS</u>: LIVE GENEROUSLY TOWARD OTHERS IN EVERY WAY (1 TIMOTHY 6:18).
 - A. Serve Do good by serving others.
 - B. Give Do good by giving generously.
- IV. <u>CONCLUSION</u>: ONLY GODLY STEWARDS EXPERIENCE TRUE WEALTH (1 TIMOTHY 6:19).
 - A. God's stewards invest in what has eternal worth.
 - B. God's stewards enjoy what has true worth in this life.
