Understanding Satan

- 1. God created all angels/spirits (Colossians 1:16; Job 38:4-7).
- 2. Some spirits (Satan/demons) "fell" rebelled against God (Isaiah 14:12-15; Ezekiel 28:11-19; 1 Timothy 3:6).
- 3. Satan is not God's equal strong, but not infinite (1 John 4:4).
- 4. Satan wants to destroy believers spiritually (1 Peter 5:8).
- I. I CAN HAVE VICTORY OVER SATAN'S SCHEMES ONLY WITH GOD'S POWER (Ephesians 6:10-11).
 - A. Be strong in the Lord's power available to you (6:10).
 - B. Put on the armor of God, depending on His power to resist satanic schemes (6:11; Ephesians 4:26-27; 2 Corinthians 2:10-11; 1 Corinthians 10:6-13).
- II. SATAN WORKS THROUGH THE WORLD SYSTEM TO TEMPT ME TO SIN (Ephesians 6:12).
 - A. The source of our temptation is not just human (6:12a).
 - B. Satan and his forces influence people and ideas in the world to draw us into sin (6:12b).
 - Satan knows what appeals to our sin nature and creates temptations in this world (1 John 2:14-16; 5:19, 21).
